Risky places for crime

Crime does not occur randomly, it tends to be concentrated in places that are 'risky'.

These places include a range of settings such as convenience stores, parks, and transit stations, even confined to particular street corners, depending on the crime.

However, our understanding of the places and settings that attract disproportionately high levels of crimes is still in its infancy.

In this seminar series, we invite prominent national and international scholars to offer us their perspective on the nature of risky places for crime and policy responses in different contexts.
