Well-Being of Black and Other Transgender People of Color

Wednesday, November 17 | 2:00 p.m.-3:30 p.m. ET

This webinar will feature a panel discussion on issues affecting transgender people who are Black, Indigenous, or from other communities of color (BIPOC).
