



Ladies and Gentlemen,

I am sending this email on behalf of the *Restorative Justice for All International Institute (RJ4All)* based in London, UK and I would like to share with you an interesting opportunity for a **free CPD certified training course**, along with **free** access to a CPD certified e-course and material, as part of a bigger project **RDaVR - Restorative Dialogue Against Violent Radicalization**.

RJ4All is proud to present its piloting training course which is convened by *Dr. Theo Gavrielides*, founder of RJ4All International Institute. It is a chance not to be missed!

It is a programme for a general (initial) training about Violent radicalization and Restorative Dialogue Strategies to be adopted for prevention and intervention. This **CPD certified** course aims to train **professionals in formal (e.g. prisons, probation, police) and informal (e.g. in the community, youth/social worker) criminal justice settings, working and supporting** offenders (and their families and carers), ex-offenders (and their families and carers), or individuals at risk of violent radicalization (and their families and carers), on how to prevent violent radicalization and how to work with individuals at risk of being radicalised.

Your participation will be valuable since it will increase everyone's personal awareness and link this to improving individual, professional and community practices!

The training course is designed to include a **pre-course reading** and a **CPD live training session** which will last approximately 6 hours. All participants will have access to pre-course reading links at least **two weeks prior** to the CPD Event and they will have time to reflect on the topics and modules which will then be developed and further discussed within the live CPD training

session. Participants usually appreciate this reflective space, often which can be quite emotive and can also bring out some personal and or professional ideals, and thoughts in advance of the CPD event.

Regarding the “live” **CPD training session**, this will last approximately 6 hours (9:00 – 17:00) and it will be carried out **in a one-day session**. The participants will have the possibility to choose between **two** available training dates:

- **on Friday, 23rd of September 2022**
- **on Saturday, 24rd of September 2022**

Regarding the venue of the session:

Restorative Justice for All International Institute has the possibility to hold the training session either **online** and/or **on a live face-to-face** format at the Centre Office in London (The RJ4All Rotherhithe Community Centre, 30 Plough Way London SE16 2LJ).

‘Hybrid’ Format Option: We would of course be happy and able to adopt a hybrid format (where there are both ‘remote’ and ‘onsite’ participants). As long as there is enough interest for a ‘hybrid attendance’, we could arrange for food and drinks during the breaks for all those at the London venue!

Therefore, at this point, we would only like to informally inquire about some of your initial ‘attendance preferences’. **Are you interested in this CPD certified training? Would you prefer to attend the session in London or remotely?**

We would very much appreciate it if we could hear back from you **until the 31st of July**, indicating your ‘attendance preferences’.

Following up to your reply, we will then be sending new emails with registration forms, joining instructions, details on the training session and advance pre/course readings.
