

24-Hour Virtual Conference on Organized Crime

Occurs online on October 30, 2024.

Deadline for applications is July 31.

A virtual conference that occurs over a continuous 24-hour period. It began during COVID, is sponsored by four NGOs, and the fifth version of the OC24 Global Conference will occur October 30-31, 2024. There will be more than 60 sessions of 75 minutes each in four parallel Zoom streams over 24 consecutive hours. The conference is free to participate and free to attend.

Last year, there were presentations by more than 300 scholars and practitioners in four session formats--- with more than 2,000 people tuning in worldwide. The range of topics is broad: Drug trafficking, the role of gender in organized crime, corruption, illicit trade and counterfeiting, organized crime and the environment, and the impact of conflict and technological developments on organized crime.

The deadline for applications is July 31, 2024. We encourage speakers from diverse backgrounds, particularly those from the Global South and early career researchers, and all those with interesting ideas or data to participate.
